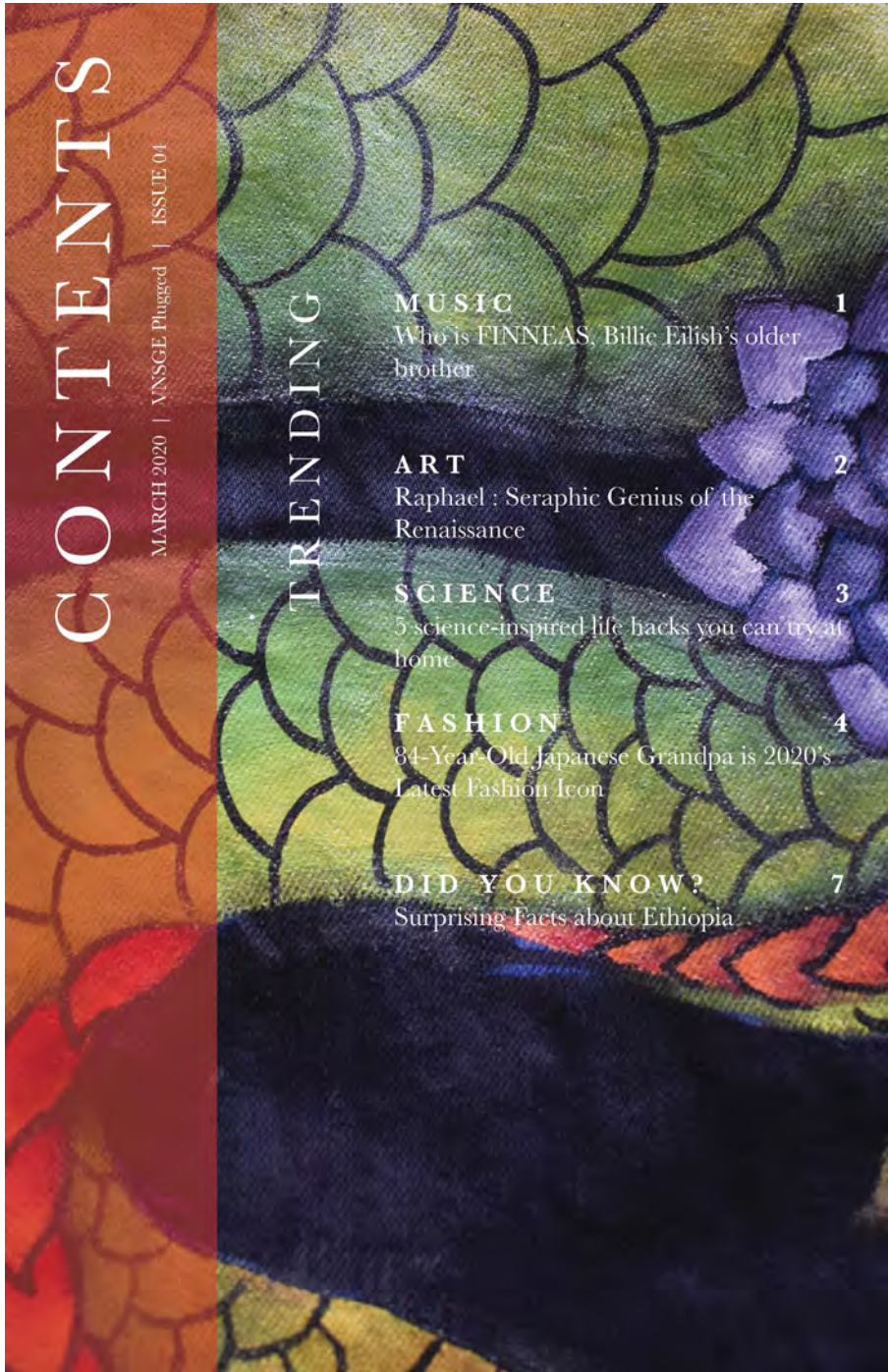

Who is FINNEAS, Billie Eilish's older brother

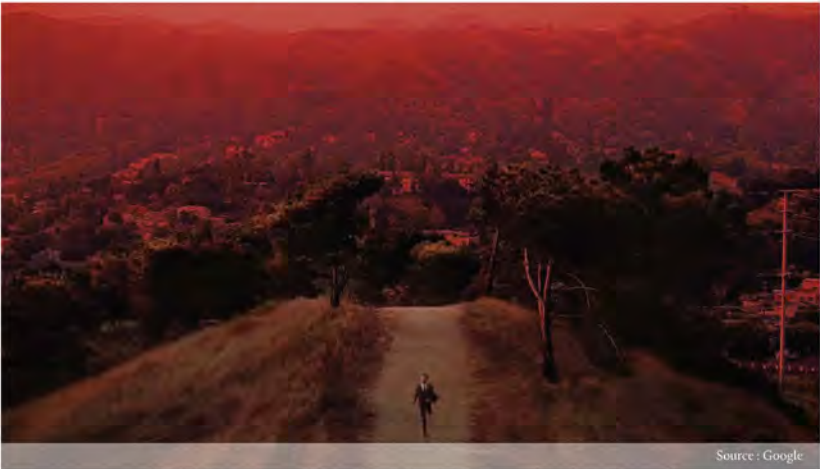
Finneas Baird O'Connell, Born on July 30, 1997, known mononymously as FINNEAS, is an American singer, songwriter, record producer, musician, and actor. He has written and produced music for various artists including his sister, singer Billie Eilish.

He won five Grammy Awards, including Album of the Year, Producer of the Year, Non-Classical and the Best Engineered Album, Non-Classical for his work on Eilish's debut album When We All Fall Asleep, Where Do We Go? .

Finneas has released several singles as a solo artist, and his debut EP, Blood Harmony, was released on October 4, 2019.



As an actor, Finneas starred in the 2013 independent film Life Inside Out. He is also known for his role as Alistair in the Fox musical comedy-drama series Glee.

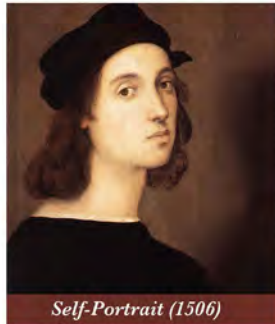

5 science-inspired life hacks you can try at home



Make your own shoe polish

Grab some olive oil and lemon for a simple stand in to shoe polish. Dab the mixture on your shoes and buff away for a perfect polish. Oils are used to keep leather soft and supple, and this mix will add some shine to keep you looking your best.

Make your own candles

Save old candle stubs because they'll come in handy. Pop a load into a bain-marie and melt them down; stir in your favourite scented oil and pour into a teacup. Pop a piece of string in the middle, all the way to the bottom, as the wick.

Get grease stains out of a top

Dropped something a bit greasy down your top? Don't turn to expensive stain removers – turn to white chalk instead. Rub chalk over the offending stain, stick it in the machine like usual, and it should all come out. The chalk absorbs the grease and the laundry detergent can then remove it.

Stop your shoes smelling

Rely on your trusty bicarbonate of soda again for this trick to stop shoes from smelling. Leave some in the offending shoes overnight, tip out in the morning and you'll have fresher smelling shoes – the alkaline bicarbonate of soda will help neutralise acidic odours.

Make your own kitchen cleaning spray

Sticky kitchen surfaces getting on your nerves? Try shaking up water, white vinegar and tea tree oil to make a DIY cleaning spray. Tip it into an old spray bottle and you're good to go. White vinegar is made of diluted acetic acid, which will help wipe away stains and even kill some germs, whilst the tea tree oil will leave your kitchen smelling clean and fresh.

Locals put it, "we waited until they had built us railways and nice buildings... and then kicked them out."

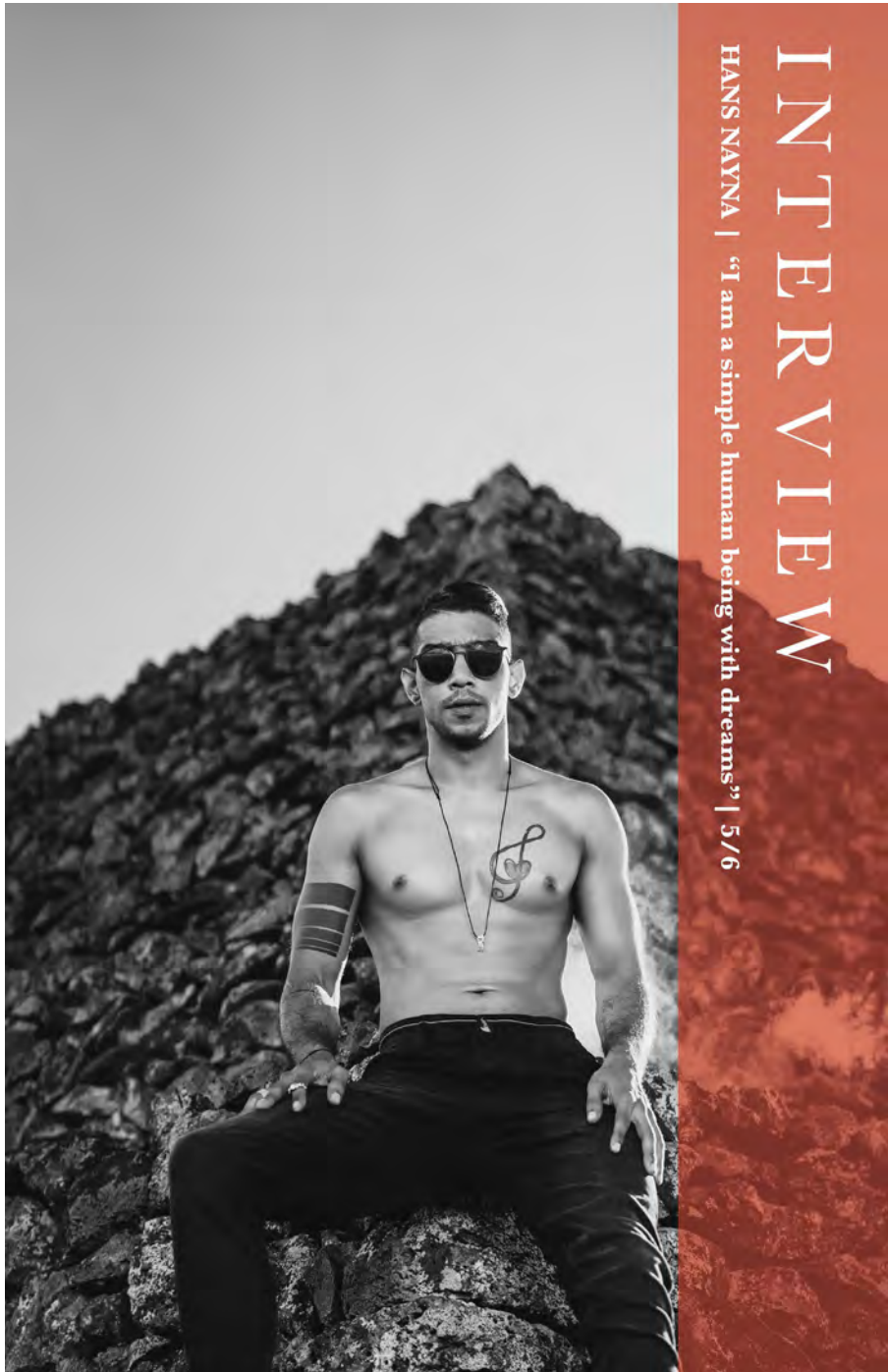
The birthplace of the Rastafarian movement
